Let's start in March 2001 at our very first t-ball program. Parents who normally must help their child during recreational activities are sitting on the bleachers talking to other parents who are journeying down the same path. Kids who are rarely selected to be on a team at school are jumping around on first base and running in the outfield with smiles on their faces and confidence in their hearts. Kids are showing off their best walk, trot, run or slide. Some who only take 10 steps by themselves in therapy are walking over 20 feet for the first time while people cheer and teammates are giving high-fives!

It's been 20 years, and only one thing has really changed. Now these experiences happen on a broader spectrum. Kinetic Kids now packs baseball fields, basketball courts, gymnastics floors, swimming pools, tracks and more all across San Antonio and New Braunfels with kids from all walks of life.

As we start our 21st year, we want to honor all the children who have walked and rolled on the Kinetic Kids path over the last 20 years. This year we pay gratitude to the young adults who were children in the early 2000's because they inspired us to ask, "If not now, then when?" Thank you to all the parents, volunteers, board members, physicians and our community who believe in the goal of getting our kids OFF the sidelines and INTO the game. We thank our amazing Kinetic Kids team of leaders; every

recreational RECAP

Powering through the pandemic, Kinetic Kids continued to provide gold standard adapted sports in 2021 by offering 191 programs and serving 2,974 children with special needs through in-person, virtual and educational programs. Determined to keep all athletes plugged in and active, our Stay Strong virtual programs were viewed almost 800 times in 2021 through training videos! We also served 205 participants via live streaming in 23 different sports and fine arts programs. By the end of the year, we transitioned to 85% in-person opportunities following all CDC guidelines and precautions.

SKATING TO A NEW TUNE

After successful one-day clinics in 2019 and 2020, we knew Kinetic Kids needed more skateboarding. Determined not to let the pandemic slow the growth of our programming, we fulfilled the dream of nine thrill-seeking athletes when we offered our first sixweek skateboarding program in the fall of 2021!

Kinetic Kids Program Administrator Andrew Garcia spearheaded the development of the program. As an experienced skateboarder, Coach Andrew understands that skateboarding is a truly individual sport that allows each rider to progress at their own pace. He explains how perfectly this sport works for athletes with disabilities, pointing out that "there is not a right or wrong way to use a skateboard, athletes can measure their own success. Our first nine skateboarders each had their own challenges to overcome, but with

much determination they accomplished their goals." Keith, who lives with spina bifida and uses a wheelchair daily, would show up eager to practice riding by sitting on a skateboard or wheeling around the park in his wheelchair. He was brave and dedicated to pushing himself to the limits. At only 6 years of age, the confidence Keith gained was tremendous. Coach Andrew loves that Keith "has the best of both worlds being able to skateboard or wheel through the park." Conny is another skateboarder who showed great progression. Because she is deaf and uses sign language to communicate, Conny is unable to voice her love for skateboarding, but you can tell through her smile and body language that she loves crushing a halfpipe. Conny struggled the first few weeks with balance, but by the end of the season she was stoked to be skateboarding.

Of course, we often measure the success of our programs simply by the joy they bring to athletes, families and volunteers. And by that measure, skateboarding will continue to be a huge success!

EXCITING DEVLOPMENTS IN 2022

- Continuing to grow and diversify programs in the San Antonio area.
- Laying the foundation needed to expand into other cities, beginning with Fort Worth.
- Cheering the return of EXPO, a free one-day resource fair set for June 17, 2022.
- Expanding our partnerships with local school districts to host field days for students with special needs.





The SA Xtreme division was developed for athletes with physical disabilities who compete in local and national parasport competitions.

Based on athlete and parent feedback, in 2021, we added

a new off-season strength and conditioning program to provide athletes the support they need to stay at the top of their games year round. AgilityFit+ features strengthening and cardio workouts, team building activities and adapted activities that kept them motivated and excited to keep their bodies in shape as they transition to the next competition season.

The search for opportunity ends here

Our SA Xtreme athletes were enthusiastic about returning to competition at Texas Regional Games in SA, Lone Star Para Invitational in Ft. Worth, Endeavor Games in Oklahoma, and the ultimate goal of Junior Nationals in Colorado. Athletes must meet qualifying times/scores to be eligible to register for Junior Nationals, which was not a hindrance for our SA Xtreme athletes. As part of the Texas team of over 50 athletes, we are proud to report that 16 SA Xtreme

athletes competed at Junior Nationals in 2021. Nine of our athletes competed in archery, in which almost all either set or broke the national record for their age and classification. We also cheered on 12 athletes in track and field and six in swimming. Whether they were competing in track lanes or pool lanes, our athletes broke several national and personal records! Once again, our athletes proved their dedication, determination and athleticism!





GET ACTIVE

collaboration means opportunity

Kinetic Kids partners with the Believe It Foundation and local school districts to provide special education students with a field day opportunity called Get Active Day. The collaboration means even more kids get off the sidelines!

At Get Active Day, our skilled coaches lead four sport stations in baseball, football, soccer and track & field. Modifying the stations as necessary, coaches and volunteers offer students the chance to be athletes for the day as they tackle skills and activities that are often new opportunities for the students with special needs.

In 2021, we held events in the south side of San Antonio and in Boerne. The Southside Get Active Day actually took two days and served 552 students



from pre-K through 12th grade in Lytle ISD, Harlandale ISD, East Central ISD and Edgewood ISD. At the Boerne ISD Get Active Day, our coaches' expertise helped serve 167 students with special needs.





In just two years, our Gingerbread Workshop has become one of our Kinetic Kids' favorite holiday traditions! In December, Kinetic Kids and Central Park Lions Club hosted 40 families outdoors at Hills & Dales Park for a day of constructing gingerbread houses, taking photos with Santa, and enjoying delicious donuts and hot chocolate. Funding was generously provided by Aerial Athletics and Walmart store #228 and the UTSA Women's Soccer team was on hand to help kids build. The weather couldn't have been better and every child walked away with a smile on their face!

PARALYMPIAN SPOTLIGHT Wyatt Struxness

Wyatt Struxness clearly recalls the first time he felt like he was "part of the team." As one of the original 12 who formed the first Kinetic Kids t-ball team, Wyatt found a place where he felt included and gained an extended family that has helped him grow into the athlete and young man he is today.

Wyatt has participated in almost every Kinetic Kids program, but like every great love story, Wyatt stumbled upon boccia ball by chance! He was competing in the 2007 Endeavor Games with Kinetic Kids when he found the sport that has changed his life. After a crash course in skills and strategy, he won his first tournament! By 2009, Wyatt had become a three-time Endeavor Game champion.

Hooked, Wyatt continued recreational play as an unclassified player until 2019 when he competed in Junior Nationals against different athletes. Focused, he observed their strategies and networked to learn their motivations. Not long after,

he was invited to Colorado
Springs to train at the Olympic
Training Center. And when he
was announced as a Team USA
Paralympic athlete in 2021,
everyone who has watched,
cheered, coached and played
alongside Wyatt was thrilled to
celebrate right alongside him.

After his first competitions as part of Team USA, Wyatt returned with new nicknames: "Baby of Boccia Ball" and "Burst of Energy." As the youngest athlete on the team, Wyatt is grateful for the opportunity to learn from the greatest athletes in the game. But he is also grateful for his roots, "Kinetic Kids instilled in me a love for sports, the ability to persevere and overcome adversity; the ability to utilize what my weaknesses are and fine tune things to add zest. Kinetic Kids gave me the ability to know that disability won't define me. It gave me relationships and so much purpose."

Wyatt continues to train up to 18 hours a week and will soon travel to Alabama to train under his Boccia Mentor, Dan Castillo.
Wyatt is excited to give back to Kinetic Kids. Be on the lookout for the opportunity to train alongside Wyatt at a Kinetic Kids Boccia clinic this spring!


