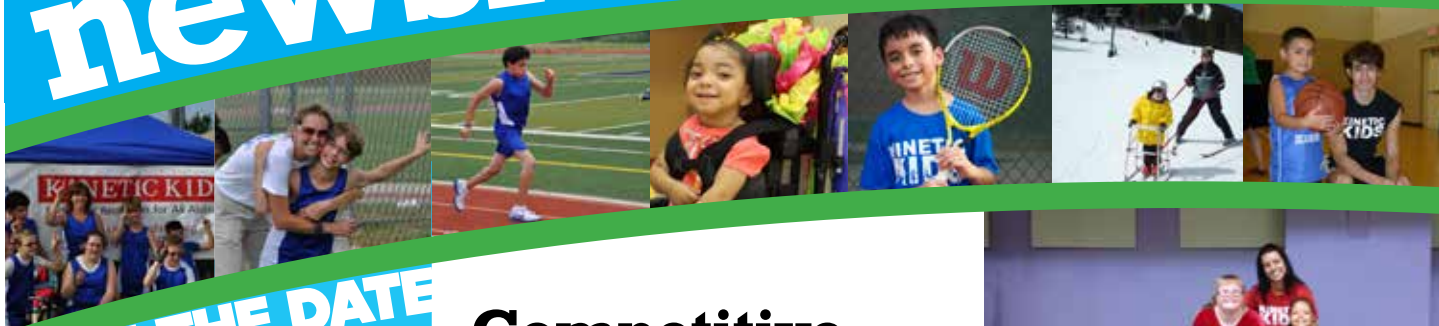

Did you know Kinetic Kids has Competitive and Performance Teams? We do! We have performance dance, competitive gymnastics, competitive cheer, Paralympic Sport Club and Endeavor Games teams.

Above & Beyond Competitive Gymnastics team was originally a separate gymnastics group founded by Amy Myers in 2001. In 2007, Amy joined forces with Kinetic Kids to further enhance her program and Kinetic Kids Competitive Gymnastics team was born.

Our Competitive Gymnastics Team is a year round program that includes girls and boys that are 8 years and older. It is a progressive gymnastics program that focuses on Special Olympics competition routines in spring, but children learn a variety of gymnastics skills year round. Outstanding gymnasts from our Kinetic Kids 8-week All Star classes are recommended by a program director to join the team.

This year our team had competitions in Houston (5 gymnasts), San Antonio (13 gymnasts), and Arlington (4 gymnasts).



At all competitions our gymnasts compete against some of the best in the state. Kinetic Kids Will Bissmeyer, Jilliann Benitez and Lexie Reiningger recently competed in our state competition and did their own personal best. 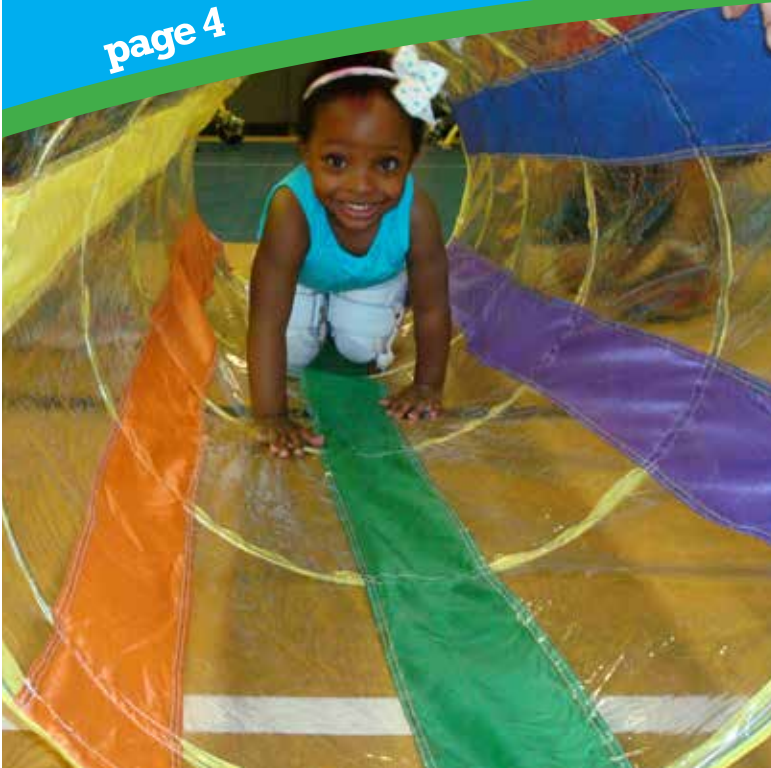
Weston Christmas Party Rocks Again!

SYDNEY MOSLEY by Anita Mosley

Sydney was born in North Carolina and moved with her parents to San Antonio when she was one and a half years old. She is a vibrant 9 year old diagnosed with mild cerebral palsy with spastic diplegia.

Sydney joined Kinetic Kids in January 2012 and has participated in several programs. The first was gymnastics, which was followed by dance, tennis, bike camp, musical theatre, track & field, wheelchair basketball and swimming. Sydney has thoroughly enjoyed each new program.

She has always liked to make new friends and learn new things; however, her involvement with Kinetic Kids has allowed her to interact with kids with similar diagnoses and that has helped her to better understand her own condition. It has also helped her to try things she never even imagined and she is even thinking about what she wants to be when she grows up in ways she never thought possible before because of her limitations. She has gained so

much confidence in her abilities in such a short period of time.

Sydney also really likes working with the staff and volunteers, but one of her other favorite things about Kinetic Kids is the trophies and awards. In fact, she just returned from the Endeavor Games in Oklahoma where she earned four gold medals and set a national record in discus.

Sydney absolutely loves Kinetic Kids! She is excited to share her experiences with her friends at school. And even though life gets busy with school, therapy, and other activities, every week she looks forward to attending Kinetic Kids programming.

Kinetic Kids is helping not only in the physical development of her strength, coordination, and wheelchair skills but it also fosters teamwork. Win a supportive and nurturing environment—truly invaluable skills. For Sydney, most of all it is about having fun!

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT: Track & Field

Every spring, our athletes with physical disabilities put in serious work to train and compete against local and national athletes in track & field events. This spring our athletes trained each week in 60m, 60m weave (powerchair athletes), 100m, 200m, 400m, and field events such as javelin, discus, shot put and club.

In April, 26 Kinetic Kids attended the 2013 Texas Regional Games and brought home gold!!

Ten athletes attended the Endeavor Games on June 8th and 9th in Edmond, Oklahoma. Our Kinetic Kids came home with 65 medals (54 gold and 11 silver) and broke 9 national records! Congratulations to our amazing athletes: Sydney Mosley, Daniel Velasquez, Seth Bosquez, Wyatt Struxness, Samuel DeRousse, Gabriel Donias, Michael Sandoval, Paul Gonzales, Mariah Kilbourne and Diana Neal.

Kinetic Kids gives a huge shout out to Coaches Scott LeBlanc, CTRS, & Chuck Smith who have given our athletes exceptional training and support this season. Big thanks also to Tiffany Neal, DPT, program director and coach, who has taken our Track and Field program to a new level!!
