a message from our FOUNDERS

Dear Kinetic Kids Family,

It feels like 2020 really started when the world came to a screeching halt in March. We were forced off the fields, down from the stages and out of art class into a new world without gatherings, socialization, teams, sports, or exercise. Some families lost jobs or worked less hours, and many of our children could no longer access their much-needed medical and rehabilitative care. Undaunted, our parents strapped on additional hero capes becoming teachers, therapists, and activity managers for their loved ones.

Over the past 20 years, our families have taught us the value of being able to adapt, and that is exactly what we did when the pandemic caused us to temporarily cease programs. We knew our Kinetic Kids could not come to us, so we decided to go to them! Our team worked tirelessly to launch our Stay Strong virtual programming in early May, giving Kinetic Kids access to pre-recorded sports activities, live programming and Zoom calls just to hang out with friends! The results were immediate: tears of joy seeing friends, compassion for each other, and best of all, the desire to stay active and positive even though the world was changing daily or even hourly! Then, as stay-at-home orders lifted, our team worked closely with federal, state and local guidelines to once again offer safe, in-person programming for our at-risk population.

Our programs may have looked a little different, but the stories of support and love are the same: mothers and daughters playing golf in masks, an older brother dancing with his little sister in her

recreational RECAP

We had completed the winter season and were just ramping up for our spring season when our world came to a standstill. To serve our recreational athletes and artists, we created Stay Strong virtual programming! Our goal was to ensure that children and their families still had a way to maintain their activity level through high-quality modified programs. We produced and published two different Stay Strong programs each week. In the end, Kinetic Kids and their families had twelve unique activities modified specifically for children with various special needs. Participants could choose their favorite sport(s) at a time best for their schedule and complete the program at their own pace to increase endurance, balance, coordination, and mobility.

Knowing our participants were missing the social interaction at our programs, we also offered live

Zoom workouts where our athletes could share details of their day, catch up with their friends, and talk to coaches who were so dearly missed.

In the fall, we offered an all-virtual, six-week musical theatre season that included a live final performance of an original play titled "Friends from Afar."

In our efforts to offer safe programming that keeps all participants engaged, we plan to continue virtual options in 2021.

A pandemic did not prevent the SA Xtreme competitive division from introducing table tennis as a new sport in 2020! The opportunity to participate in person at a new event was a highlight for many athletes. Designed for athletes who only have physical disabilities, SA Xtreme athletes initially attended virtual workouts designed specifically for them. When it was finally safe to utilize social distancing, they met in an open field for a mock archery competition to train for the 2020 Virtual Endeavor Games.

Determined to compete, three SAX track & field athletes also traveled to Marble Falls in October to participate in the adapted division of an ablebodied competition!

The search for opportunity ends here

Imagine your child longing for a place to belong. In 2015, this was Analisa Spicer's reality. Her daughter Noelani had just turned three, and Analisa's search for special needs programs was frustrating. "It was disheartening. Many would not accommodate children with different physical abilities, or those who weren't neurotypical," she recalled.

When Noelani's physical therapist recommended swim lessons to strengthen her core and leg muscles, Analisa shared her struggles finding a place welcoming children who are incontinent or in need of 1:1 assistance. Of course her therapist had the answer—Kinetic Kids. "Not only did Kinetic Kids accommodate Noelani, but they embrace her differences and empower her to be the best she can be. For that, Noelani and I will forever be grateful."

Noelani has participated in recreational programs and in our San Antonio Xtreme competitive division. When the pandemic forced the Spicer family into isolation due to Noelani's medical fragility, our virtual programs helped her cope with the emotional and physical effects of social distancing.

> Analisa remembers fondly, "Every week, my daughter counted down to her musical theater class where she could visit with old friends and make new ones. And when I told her about the new virtual dance and martial arts classes, her squeals of delight reminded me how crucial these programs are for children like mine. I don't know what life might be like if Kinetic Kids didn't exist, and I don't want to imagine a world without it."





Standing outside their homes in March, Program Directors Jamie Rodell and Monica Deschaine turned on their video cameras and their 1000-watt smiles and began our first Facebook Live workout for the San Antonio Premier CrossFit program. Determined to keep our athletes strong both physically and emotionally, our coaches also added Zoom sessions where athletes could simply chat and catch up with their friends.





DISCOVERING DISABILITIES DAY educating & enlightening peers

Discovering Disabilities Day events are co-hosted with local elementary schools to educate students about disabilities and encourage inclusion. Kinetic Kids partners with community organizations, therapists and school staff members to offer hands-on activities that simulate the experience of adapting to different abilities. Increasing awareness increases compassion and understanding which lead to more welcoming environments for children with special needs.

After hosting just one in-person event in 2020, schools closed due to the pandemic. So, we continued providing valuable insight through our social media platforms. We created videos highlighting athletes



with different diagnoses, giving them an opportunity to share their stories and abilities. In 2021, we plan to provide additional virtual activities and resources for those who want to learn more about our amazing Kinetic Kids.



TWO WHEELS IN FIVE DAYS bike camp fosters independence

Due to the generosity of Believe It Foundation, Kinetic Kids collaborates with the national organization, iCan Shine, each summer to help children with special needs learn to ride a conventional bicycle without training wheels. Taking pandemic protocols into consideration, we were thrilled to welcome 22 cyclists and 40 volunteers to Bike Camp 2020. And our participants were just as happy, "Hailey has had much more interest in riding a bike at home and has been willing to help her little sister and other friends learn to ride now," reports the Ayoub family. Liam, a volunteer, is also grateful, "I know a lot of things were canceled because of the pandemic, so I am glad I was able to participate."

Recognizing the significant size of the task, Amy took a crash course in video editing so she could help get programs to our athletes as quickly as possible. Not only did she navigate unchartered waters for her teaching position, she also took on a whole new technical role at Kinetic Kids recording gymnastics programs, hosting Zoom calls in the evenings and editing videos on the weekends!

She says it is easy to stay committed to helping our Kinetic Kids, "Whenever I help a Kinetic Kid reach a first like jumping on both feet or doing a forward roll, I think 'WOW!' I was a part of that!"
